

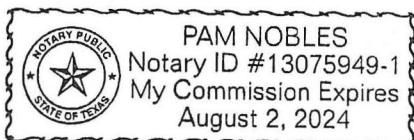

Proposed Permit No. 2406

**Application.** PC-II, LLC, 300 Concourse Blvd., Suite 101, Ridgeland, Madison County, Mississippi 39157, a Mississippi limited liability company, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for a separate land use compatibility determination on a permit to authorize a new Municipal Solid Waste Type I Landfill. The facility is located approximately seven miles northwest of the intersection of US 59 and SH 105, San Jacinto County, Texas. The TCEQ received the land use compatibility portion of the application on August 28, 2019. **Additional Notice.** The TCEQ Executive Director has determined that the land use compatibility portion of the application is administratively complete and will conduct a substantive review of this portion of the application. Following completion of that review, the TCEQ will make a separate determination on the question of land use compatibility. If the site is determined to be compatible with the surrounding land uses, the TCEQ may at another time consider conformity with other regulatory requirements. After completing the land use compatibility review, the TCEQ will issue a Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision. Notice of the Application and Preliminary Decision will be published and mailed to those who are on the county-wide mailing list and to those who are on the mailing list for this application. That notice will contain the deadline for submitting public comments.

**Public Comment/Public Meeting.** You may submit public comments or request a public meeting on this application. The purpose of a public meeting is to provide the opportunity to submit comments or to ask questions about the application. TCEQ will hold a public meeting if the Executive Director determines that there is a significant degree of public interest in the application or if requested by a local legislator. A public meeting is not a contested case hearing.

**Opportunity for a Contested Case Hearing.** After the deadline for submitting public comments, the Executive Director will consider all timely comments and prepare a response to all relevant and material, or significant public comments. Unless the application is directly referred for a contested case hearing, the response to comments, and the Executive Director's decision on the application, will be mailed to everyone who submitted public comments and to those persons who are on the mailing list for this application. If comments are received, the mailing will also provide instructions for requesting reconsideration of the Executive Director's decision and for requesting a contested case hearing. A person who may be affected by the facility is entitled to request a contested case hearing from the commission. A contested case hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

**To Request a Contested Case Hearing, You Must Include The Following Items in Your Request:** your name, address, phone number; applicant's name and permit number; the location and distance of your property/activities relative to the facility; a specific description of how you would be adversely affected by the facility in a way not common to the general public; a list of all disputed issues of fact that you submit during the comment period, and the statement "[I/we] request a contested case hearing." If the request for contested case hearing is filed on behalf of a group or association, the request must designate the group's representative for receiving future correspondence; identify by name and physical address an individual member of the group who would be adversely affected by the facility or activity; provide the information discussed above regarding the affected member's location and distance from the facility or activity; explain how and why the member would be affected; and explain how the interests the group seeks to protect are relevant to the group's purpose.

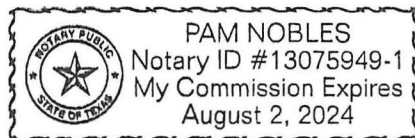
