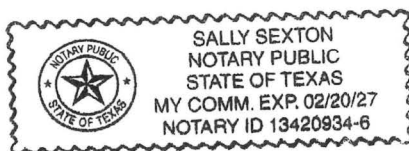

APPLICATION.

JC Water Resource Recovery Facility, LLC, 525 South Loop 288, Suite 105, Denton, Texas 76205, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for new Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0016386001, to authorize the discharge of treated domestic wastewater at a daily average flow not to exceed 108,000 gallons per day.

The facility will be located approximately 0.25 miles east of the intersection of U.S. Highway 67 and County Road 1226, near the city of Cleburne, in Johnson County, Texas 76033. The treated effluent will be discharged to an unnamed tributary, thence to Robinson Branch, thence to Lake Pat Cleburne in Segment No. 1228 of the Brazos River Basin. The unclassified receiving water use is limited aquatic life use for the unnamed tributary and Robinson Branch. The designated uses for Segment No. 1228 are primary contact recreation, public water supply, and high aquatic life use. In accordance with 30 TAC § 307.5 and the TCEQ's Procedures to Implement the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards (June 2010), an antidegradation review of the receiving waters was performed. A Tier 1 antidegradation review has preliminarily determined that existing water quality uses will not be impaired by this permit action. Numerical and narrative criteria to protect existing uses will be maintained. This review has preliminarily determined that no water bodies with exceptional, high, or intermediate aquatic life uses are present within the stream reach assessed; therefore, no Tier 2 degradation determination is required. No significant degradation of water quality is expected in water bodies with exceptional, high, or intermediate aquatic life uses downstream, and existing uses will be maintained and protected. The preliminary determination can be reexamined and may be modified if new information is received. The TCEQ Executive Director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared a draft permit. The draft permit, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The Executive Director has made a preliminary decision that this permit, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements. The permit application, Executive Director's preliminary decision, and draft permit are available for viewing and copying at Cleburne Public Library, 302 West Henderson Street, Cleburne, Texas.

The hearing will address the disputed issues of fact identified in the TCEQ order concerning this application issued on July 29, 2025. In addition to these issues, the judge may consider additional issues if certain factors are met.

The hearing will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001, Texas Government Code; Chapter 26, Texas Water Code; and the procedural rules of the TCEQ and SOAH, including 30 TAC Chapter 80 and 1 TAC Chapter 155. The hearing will be held unless all timely hearing requests have been withdrawn or denied.

To request to be a party, you must attend the hearing and show you would be adversely affected by the application in a way not common to members of the general public. Any person may attend the hearing and request to be a party. Only persons named as parties may participate at the hearing.

JC Water Resource Recovery Facility, LLC, 525 South Loop 288, Suite 105, Denton, Texas 76205, ha solicitado a la Comisión de Calidad Ambiental de Texas (TCEQ, por sus siglas en inglés) un nuevo Permiso N.º WQ0016386001, autorizar la descarga de aguas residuales domésticas tratadas con un caudal promedio diario que no exceda los 108,000 galones por día.

La instalación estará ubicada aproximadamente a 0.25 millas al este de la intersección de la autopista U.S. Highway 67 y County Road 1226, cerca de la ciudad de Cleburne, en el Condado de Johnson, Texas 76033. El efluente tratado se descargará un afluente no identificado, de allí a Robinson Branch, de allí al lago Pat Cleburne en el segmento N.º 1228 de la cuenca del Río Brazos. El uso no clasificado del agua receptora es un uso limitado de la vida acuática para el afluente sin nombre y Robinson Branch. Los usos designados para el Segmento N.º 1228 son recreación de contacto primario, suministro público de agua y alto uso de vida acuática. De acuerdo con 30 TAC § 307.5 y los *Procedimientos para Implementar los Estándares de Calidad del Agua Superficial de Texas de la TCEQ* (junio del 2010), se realizó una revisión antidegradación de las aguas receptoras. Una revisión antidegradación de Nivel 1 ha determinado preliminarmente que los usos existentes de la calidad del agua no se verán afectados por esta acción de permiso. Se mantendrán los criterios numéricos y descriptivos para proteger los usos existentes. Esta revisión ha determinado preliminarmente que no hay cuerpos de agua con usos excepcionales, altos o intermedios de vida acuática dentro del tramo de arroyo evaluado; por lo tanto, no se requiere ninguna determinación de degradación de nivel 2. No se espera una degradación significativa de la calidad del agua en los cuerpos de agua con usos excepcionales, altos o intermedios de la vida acuática aguas abajo, y los usos existentes se mantendrán y protegerán. La determinación preliminar puede ser reexaminada y puede ser modificada si se recibe nueva información. NOTICE OF HEARING

A hearing was requested on issues related to your application and the Commission granted this request. The matter has been referred to the State Office of Administrative Hearings. Now you must comply with the following instructions:

Please Review Notice

We have included in the hearing notice all of the information which we believe is necessary. Please read it carefully and notify us immediately if it contains any errors or omissions. You are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of all information published. You may not change the text of the notice without prior approval from the TCEQ.

Newspaper Notice

- You must publish the enclosed Notice of Hearing no less than **30** days before the hearing.
- You must publish the enclosed Notice of Hearing at least once and at your expense, in a newspaper that is regularly published or circulated in each county where, by virtue of the county's geographical relation to the subject matter of the hearing, a person may reasonably believe persons reside who may be affected by the action that may be taken as a result of the hearing. 

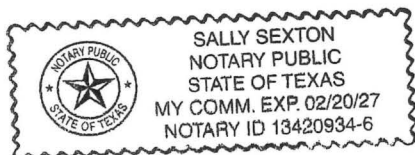

No se espera una degradación significativa de la calidad del agua en los cuerpos de agua con usos excepcionales, altos o intermedios de la vida acuática aguas abajo, y los usos existentes se mantendrán y protegerán. La determinación preliminar puede ser reexaminada y puede ser modificada si se recibe nueva información. Your application has been declared administratively complete. You must comply with the following instructions. There are seven (7) steps involved in publishing notice. Complete each step.

1. REVIEW THE NOTICE FOR ACCURACY

Read the enclosed notice carefully and notify the Application Review and Processing Team at 512-239-4671 immediately if it contains any errors or omissions. You are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of all information published. Do not change the text or formatting of the notice or affidavit of publication without prior approval from the TCEQ.
