#### APPLICATION.

130 Environmental Park LLC, 5200 N US Highway 183 (NB), Lockhart Texas 78644, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for a permit amendment to authorize the expansion of waste acceptance hours to 5:00 am to 7:00 pm, Monday through Friday, and 6:00 pm on Saturdays and operating hours to 5:00 am to 9:00 pm, Monday through Friday, and 6:00 am to 6:00 pm on Saturdays. The facility is located at 5200 N US Highway 183 (NB), Lockhart 78644 in Caldwell County, Texas. The TCEQ received this application on December 22, 2021. The TCEQ Executive Director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared a draft limited scope amendment document. The draft limited scope amendment, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The Executive Director has made a preliminary decision that this permit amendment, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements. The permit amendment application, Executive Director's preliminary decision, and draft limited scope amendment document are available for viewing and copying at Dr. Eugene Clark Library, 217 S. ### CONTESTED CASE HEARING.

The State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) will conduct a preliminary hearing via Zoom videoconference. A Zoom meeting is a secure, free meeting held over the internet that allows video, audio, or audio/video conferencing.

The purpose of a preliminary hearing is to establish jurisdiction, name the parties, establish a procedural schedule for the remainder of the proceeding, and to address other matters as determined by the judge. The evidentiary hearing phase of the proceeding, which will occur at a later date, will be similar to a civil trial in state district court. The hearing will address the disputed issues of fact identified in the TCEQ order issued on December 21, 2023, concerning this application. In addition to these issues, the judge may consider additional issues if certain factors are met.

The hearing will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001, Texas Government Code; Chapter 361, Texas Health and Safety Code; TCEQ rules, including 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 330; and the procedural rules of TCEQ and SOAH, including 30 TAC Chapter 80 and 1 TAC Chapter 155. The hearing will be held unless all timely hearing requests have been withdrawn or denied.

To request to be a party, you must attend the hearing and show you would be adversely affected by the application in a way not common to members of the general public. Any person may attend the preliminary hearing and request to be a party. Only persons named as parties may participate in the hearing.

In accordance with 1 TAC § 155.401(a), Notice of Hearing, "Parties that are not represented by an attorney may obtain information regarding contested case hearings on the public website of the State Office of Administrative Hearings at www.soah.texas.gov, or in printed format upon request to SOAH."
