

## **Notice of Stakeholder Meeting on Disability Nondiscrimination Plan, Public Participation Plan, and Language Access Plan**

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ or Agency) will hold a virtual meeting on **June 20, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. CDT**. Simultaneous professional language interpretation in Spanish will be provided during the meeting. The purpose of this meeting is to solicit input from all stakeholders on implementation of the Agency's Disability Nondiscrimination Plan, Public Participation Plan, and Language Access Plan (Plans). Agency staff will also discuss recent actions related to implementation of the Plans.
