The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) is requesting that you submit a completed FY20XX Air Emissions/Inspection Fee Basis Form for SITE, RN, AIR ACCOUNT XXXXXXX, within 60 days from the date of this notification. Agency records indicate that your company owns or operates an account (site) that may be required to pay either the air inspection fee per 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §101.24 or the air emissions fee per 30 TAC §101.27.

Please complete and submit the Fee Basis Form to Airfees@tceq.texas.gov by the due date.

Failure to respond to this request may result in TCEQ enforcement actions.

If the site is no longer operating, has been sold, or party to pending bankruptcy proceedings you are still required to submit a completed Fee Basis Form to notify the program area of the change.
