What Is STEERS?

STEERS, or State of Texas Environmental Electronic Reporting System, is a Web reporting system created by us, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, or TCEQ, for your use as the owner or operator of a regulated entity. STEERS provides a secure electronic infrastructure for reporting information to us to meet reporting obligations under air, water, and waste.



What Is Web-EI?

The Annual Emissions Inventory Report, or AEIR, is a program area in STEERS for all data related to the Air Emissions Inventory, and is referred to as Web-El. Using Web-El reporting, you can submit the annual Emissions Inventory Questionnaire, or EIQ, online. There are two options available—you can either:

• Enter the EIQ data online through the dataentry screens (EIQ Entry).

OR

• Upload a text file that meets our file-format requirements (File Upload).

Benefits of Web-El Reporting

- Saves money because there are no associated printing or mailing costs.
- Promotes efficiency by allowing several people to work on the same inventory anywhere an Internet connection is available.
- Saves time getting necessary signatures—no mailing to officials is needed.
- Avoids possible misinterpretation of handwritten data.
- Improves accuracy and reduces revisions through automated data checks.
- Generates totals for criteria pollutants.
- Provides e-mail acknowledgments during the submission process.
- Provides an electronic copy of the submission record.
- Satisfies the requirements of our EIQ reporting rule.
- Provides an easier process for preparing and submitting an initial El.

Web-El Reporting in Four Ecisy Sleps

Set up a **STEERS** account: <www.tceq. texas.gov/ goto/steers>.

Select the appropriate regulated entity reference number (RN) to update.

Select either EIQ **Entry** (to update data through a series of interactive Web pages) or File Upload (to submit the delta text file by uploading it from your computer).

The Status of Web-El Reporting in Texas


- Nearly 5.000 EIQs have been submitted through the Web.
