The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) is requesting that you submit a completed Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 Air Emissions/Inspection Fee Basis Form. Agency records indicate that your company owns or operates an account (site) that may be required to pay either the air inspection fee per 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §101.24 or the air emissions fee per 30 TAC §101.27.

If a site will be active for any portion of FY 2023 (September 1, 2022, through August 31, 2023), then one or both fees may apply. If both fees are applicable to a site, the TCEQ will assess the higher of these two fees. The inspection fee applies to sites operating under one of the listed standard industrial classification codes in 30 TAC §101.24; the emissions fee applies to sites subject to Title V permitting requirements.

The TCEQ has transitioned to an electronic Air Emissions/Inspection Fee Basis Form. Please complete and submit the attached fee basis form to <a href="mailto:Airfees@tceq.texas.gov">Airfees@tceq.texas.gov</a>.

Using the information reported in the fee form, the TCEQ will determine the applicable FY 2023 fee amount and will send the fee invoice in October 2022.

The TCEQ Air Emissions/Inspection Fee Basis Form is due within 60 days from the date of this email. To avoid TCEQ enforcement actions, the completed Air Emissions/Inspection Fee Basis Form must be received by the TCEQ on or before the specified due date.
