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SIP Revision: Collin County Lead Attainment Demonstration, June 18, 1993

On June 18, 1993, the Texas Air Control Board (TACB) adopted an attainment demonstration State Implementation Plan (SIP) revision for lead in the Collin County nonattainment area.

Summary of the SIP Revision

Adoption Date: 06/18/1993

EPA Approval Date: 11/29/1994 ([59 FR 60905](#))

Background: This SIP revision was adopted by the TACB on June 18, 1993 and fulfilled the requirement that the state submit an attainment demonstration for the lead standard in Collin County, which had previously been designated nonattainment. This plan was required to demonstrate that the nonattainment area would attain the lead standard by January 6, 2007.

Key Changes:

This SIP revision included:

- An air quality analysis through 1992;
- A 1992 emissions inventory (EI);
- Dispersion modeling demonstrating National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS) attainment for the area;
- New Source Review (NSR) provisions for lead sources;
- Agreed orders controlling fugitive dust emissions;
- Permit provisions; and
- Contingency measures.
