SIP Revisions: Dallas-Fort Worth (DFW) 1997 Eight-Hour Ozone Nonattainment Area (Contingency Measures Plan), November 5, 2008

On November 5, 2008, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) adopted a contingency measures State Implementation Plan (SIP) revision for the DFW 1997 eight-hour ozone nonattainment area.

Summary of the SIP Revision

Adoption Date: 11/05/2008

Proposal Date: 08/06/2008

EPA Action: 01/14/2009 ([74 FR 1903](#)). Final approval is contingent on approval of the Discrete Emissions Reduction Credit (DERC) plan and rules.

Background and Key Changes: On July 14, 2008, the EPA proposed conditional approval ([73 FR 40203](#)) of the May 2007 DFW attainment demonstration (AD) SIP Revision, providing that final conditional approval was contingent upon the State of Texas adopting and submitting to the EPA an approvable contingency plan SIP revision for the DFW area. The contingency measures plan SIP revision was adopted by the commission on November 5, 2008, and submitted to the EPA on November 15, 2008. This SIP revision identified measures to satisfy the EPA's 3% reduction contingency requirement for 2010 for the DFW area, to apply in the event that the DFW area failed to meet the 1997 eight-hour ozone standard by the attainment deadline.
