SIP Revision: Carbon Monoxide (CO) Moderate Area Attainment Demonstration, El Paso, September 18, 1992

On September 18, 1992, the Texas Air Control Board (TACB) adopted an attainment demonstration State Implementation Plan (SIP) revision to address CO nonattainment in El Paso.

Summary of the SIP Revision

Adoption Date: 09/18/1992

EPA Approval Dates: CO emissions inventory (EI) and oxygenated fuels program approved on 09/12/1994 ([59 FR 46766](#)); New Source Review (NSR) provisions approved on 9/27/1995 ([60 FR 49781](#))

Background: As a result of the 1990 Federal Clean Air Act (FCAA) Amendments, a portion of the City of El Paso was classified as moderate nonattainment for CO. Texas was not specifically required to submit an attainment demonstration due to the level of the design value. However, based on the requirements of Section 179B of the Federal Clean Air Act (FCAA), the TACB conducted modeling to show that El Paso would be in attainment of the CO National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS) by the attainment deadline based on United States emissions alone.

Key Changes:

This SIP revision included:

- A comprehensive 1990 base year emissions inventory (EI);
- An oxygenated fuel program for El Paso County;
- New source review provisions for major CO sources; and
- A commitment to make corrections to the existing inspection and maintenance (I/M) program.
