## SIP Revision: El Paso Electric Products Inc. (Site-Specific), April 1993

In April 1993, the Texas Air Control Board (TACB) adopted a State Implementation Plan (SIP) revision to address El Paso Electrical Products, Inc.'s application for an exemption from the provisions of the rules pertaining to emission specifications and alternate control requirements for certain surface coating operations.

## **Summary of the SIP Revision**

Adoption Date: 04/1993

**Background:** TACB regulations allowed certain surface coating operations exemptions from the general volatile organic compounds (VOC) reasonably available control technology (RACT) control requirements and instead allowed these operations to adopt alternate controls when the source's emissions were minimal, the cost of adding controls was prohibitive, and the source provided supporting documentation to the TACB and the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). El Paso Electric Products, Inc. conducted paper-coating operations, and this SIP revision allowed for an alternate method of coating mica paper, as long as the company followed the alternate control requirements specified in the revision.
