SIP Revision: Vehicle Inspection and Maintenance (I/M) Program, Houston-Galveston (HGA), October 8, 2003

On October 8, 2003, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) adopted a State Implementation Plan (SIP) revision for the I/M Program in the HGA area.

Summary of the SIP Revision

Adoption Date: 10/08/2003

Proposal Date: 07/09/2003

EPA Approval Date: 09/06/2006 (71 FR 52670 )

Background and Key Changes: On October 8, 2003, the TCEQ adopted a revision to the I/M program (30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 114, Control of Air Pollution from Motor Vehicles) for the nonattainment area of HGA. This SIP revision incorporated rule revisions that delayed for one year the start of the I/M program and the early participation incentive program for vehicles registered in Chambers, Liberty, and Waller Counties. There were no additional changes aside from the delay of the program start dates.
