# SIP Revision: 2014 Five-Year Regional Haze (Progress Report), February 26, 2014

On February 26, 2014, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) adopted a Five-Year Regional Haze Progress Report State Implementation Plan (SIP) revision.

## Summary of the SIP Revision

**Adoption Date:** 02/26/2014

**Proposal Date:** 06/19/2013

**EPA Approval Date:** Pending

**Background and Key Changes:** The 2014 Five-Year Regional Haze SIP revision satisfies the federal regional haze rule, which requires states to submit progress reports for each mandatory Class I federal area in the state every five years (40 CFR §51.308(g)). The report must evaluate improvement towards the reasonable progress goal for each mandatory Class I federal area located within and outside the state that may be affected by emissions from Texas.

This progress report contains:

- a summary of emissions reductions achieved from the plan;
- an assessment of visibility conditions and changes for each Class I area in Texas and that Texas may impact;
- an analysis of emissions reductions by pollutant; and
- a review of Texas' visibility monitoring strategy and any necessary modifications.
