SIP Revision: Stage II Vapor Recovery Program, November 10, 1993

On November 10, 1993, the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) adopted a State Implementation Plan (SIP) revision for the Stage II Vapor Recovery Program.

Summary of the SIP Revision

Adoption Date: 11/10/1993

EPA Approval Date: 04/15/1994 ([59 FR 17940](#))

Background and Key Changes: This SIP revision incorporated requirements for Stage II vapor recovery systems laid out in the technical guidance the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued in 1991. The state had already adopted a SIP revision that established Stage II vapor recovery programs in the state's four ozone nonattainment areas in 1992. The purpose of this SIP revision was to facilitate implementation of the Stage II vapor recovery program in Texas and improve rule effectiveness by clarifying aspects of provisions for agency-conducted annual investigations and testing requirements.
