SIP Revision: Control of Total Suspended Particulate (TSP) Air Pollution, July 11, 1980

On July 11, 1980, the Texas Air Control Board (TACB) adopted a State Implementation Plan (SIP) revision to address areas in violation of the particulate matter (PM) standard that had not been fully addressed in the 1979 SIP revision.

Summary of the SIP Revision

Adoption Date: 07/11/1980

Background: As a result of negotiations with the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) after the submittal of the PM SIP revisions in 1979, this SIP revision was adopted by the TACB on July 11, 1980 and included control strategies and emission inventories (EI) for areas in violation of the PM standard that had not been fully addressed in the 1979 Ozone, Particulate Matter, and Carbon Monoxide SIP. This included areas in San Benito, Brownsville, Corpus Christi, Dallas, and El Paso. The SIP was required in order to gain full EPA approval following the plan's conditional approval on March 25, 1980 ([45 FR 19231](#)).
