Fund Your Alternative Fueling Facilities Project

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) provides grants for the construction or reconstruction of alternative fuel facilities in the Clean Transportation Zone (CTZ). Individuals, state and local governments, corporations, and any other legal entity may be eligible.

Eligible Projects:

Eligible alternative fuel types for projects include compressed natural gas, liquified natural gas, or a combination of the



two; hydrogen; biodiesel; biodiesel blends; propane; electricity; and methanol (at least 85% by volume).

- Eligible projects must include the construction or reconstruction of an alternative fueling facility.
- Facilities that are open to the public will be considered for funding before private ones.
