1. Required Information & Documentation

The applicant must provide the equipment information requested in Section 6 of the application and attach documentation and color photographs of the third-party equipment (including engine) to the application.

2. Third-Party Equipment Certifications

By signing below, the applicant and current owner of the equipment certify that the equipment meets the following requirements.

a. Operation. The equipment has been continuously operated in Texas for the two years immediately preceding the application signature date.
b. Condition. The equipment is currently in operating condition and has a remaining useful life of 5 or more years.
c. Qualifying Equipment. The equipment will be replaced with a qualifying piece of equipment of the same horsepower range and used in the same application or vocation.

3. Current Equipment Owner Signature
