

Clean Energy Fleets for Texas

Governmental Alternative Fuel Fleet Grant Program (GAFF)

If you're looking to expand or upgrade your fleet with cleaner energy models; the GAFF grant program, part of the Texas Emissions Reduction Plan (TERP) provides funding to purchase or lease new fleet vehicles that operate on alternative fuels.



\$4 million in funding available

Eligible Applicants

State agencies, counties, municipalities, school districts, junior college districts, river authorities, water or other special districts, or other political subdivisions that operate a fleet of more than 15 vehicles.



Eligible Projects

TCEQ will award GAFF grants on a competitive basis to purchase or lease new on-road vehicles that operate using the following alternative fuels:

- Compressed Natural Gas (CNG)
- Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG)
- Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG)
- Hydrogen (fuel cells)
- Electricity (including fully electric and plug-in hybrids)

**Up to 10% of awarded funds may be granted for the purchase, lease, or installation of refueling infrastructure or equipment, or refueling services in conjunction with an eligible vehicle purchase or lease with the same alternative fuel type.*



Eligible Areas

Grants under this grant round are available statewide, with priority given to projects in the nonattainment areas and affected counties

El Paso Area: El Paso

San Antonio Area: Bexar

Tyler-Longview Area: Rusk

Other Areas: Anderson, Freestone, Howard, Hutchinson, Navarro, Panola & Titus
