Light-Duty Motor Vehicle Purchase or Lease Incentive Program

- Rebates awarded statewide on a first-come, first-served basis
- Eligible rebate amounts:
 - Up to \$5,000 for compressed natural gas (CNG) or liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) vehicles
 - Up to \$2,500 for hydrogen fuel cell or other electric drive (hybrid plug-in or plug-in) vehicles



Light-Duty Motor Vehicle Purchase or Lease Incentive Program

- Rebates will be awarded up to the statutory limit for each type of vehicle, until all available funding has been awarded, or until 1/7/2023
 - Up to 1,000 CNG or LPG vehicles
 - Up to 2,000 hydrogen fuel cell or other electric drive vehicles

Dealer or Lessor Document Requirements

- Purchase Documents
 - Buyer's Order
 - Retail Installment Contract
 - Lease Contract
 - Purchase Agreement
 - Lease Agreement
- Registration Document
 - Form 130-U: Application for Texas Title and/or Registration

All documents must be complete, with both applicant and dealer or lessor signatures





Eligibility Requirements

- Must be new, not subject to a previous sale
- Must meet the eligibility criteria for the program as outlined in the Notice of Rebates (NoR)
- Purchased or leased on or after 09/01/2021
- Purchased or leased through a Texas dealer or lessor
- No grants available for entities that purchase or lease vehicles from itself





Reservation Process

- The TCEQ will accept reservations for vehicles placed on order to hold an applicant's place in line.
