During our conference call of December 19, 2023, I described that NGE has been unable to obtain a response from CPS Energy about technical questions asked of CPS Energy regarding the CPS Energy potential use of the flow batteries that are the subject of NTIG 582-21-23793-NG.

Kevin Pollo, Vice President of Energy Supply & Market Operations, and Domingo Villarreal, Principal | Wholesale Power Solutions, discussed the matter of the potential use of CPS of the flow batteries. Mr. Pollo assigned Domingo Villarreal the task of having the information that we would send reviewed so that NGE could reflect that in a cost proposal for the energy using those batteries.

NGE sent the information request to CPS, but no reply has been received. Since then, CPS Energy has issued several RFPs for solar energy, some of which included battery stored energy. NGE suspects that among the reasons CPS Energy is not responding is that those RFP packages have not been awarded yet. The situation is further complicated by NGE having replied with an RFP response to at least one of those RFPs which could prohibit NGE from speaking to CPS Energy about solar and storage batteries.
