Project Summary (150 words or less): PWRPAC LLC, as an Owner & Operator proposes to design, procure, construct, develop, operate, and maintain Lithium-Ion based Battery Energy Electricity Storage System (RBESS) rated at 1.05MW Power Capacity, and 1.45MWh Energy capacity. The project site is located along SH349 in Martin County, Texas, approximately 16.2 miles North of Midland along SH349. The system is primarily intended to help Texas Electric Grid with resilience and support in times of load shedding and peak loads, as determined by Electric Utility.
