Drive Your Efficiency

Seaport and Rail Yard Areas Emissions Reduction Program (SPRY)

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) provides grants for the replacement or repower of older drayage trucks and cargo handling equipment operating in Texas seaports and rail yards.





Grant amounts may cover up to 80% of the cost to replace a piece of equipment with a newer one or repower an existing one.

Eligible applicants include individuals, state and local governments, corporations, and any other legal entity.

Drayage trucks and cargo handling equipment eligible for replacement or repower include:

- Vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating over 26,000 lbs.
- Yard trucks
- Cargo handling equipment (e.g., container handlers, forklifts, and loaders)

Drayage trucks and cargo handling equipment must currently, and for the two years before submitting an application, be:

- Used in the daily operations of the applicant.
- Operated at least 200 days per year in an eligible Texas seaport or rail yard.
- Registered and operated in Texas.
- Owned or leased by the applicant.

Eligible Counties

Grant-funded drayage trucks and cargo handling equipment must:

Be operated at least 55% of total annual operation in one or more of the eligible counties.
Visit an eligible seaport or rail yard at least 200 times per year.

El Paso Area: El Paso

Houston-Galveston-Brazoria Area: Brazoria, Chambers, Fort Bend, Galveston, Harris, Liberty, Montgomery & Waller

San Antonio Area: Bexar, Comal, Guadalupe & Wilson

Tyler-Longview Area: Gregg, Harrison, Rusk, Smith & Upshur

Other Areas: Anderson, Freestone, Howard, Hutchinson, Navarro, Panola & Titus
