### Request for Raw Agricultural Product Transport Exemption

Under the Texas Health and Safety Code, Chapter 386, Subchapter (B), Section 386.0515, projects involving the transport of raw agricultural products may be exempt from the requirements that grant-funded vehicles operate at least 75% of annual mileage in the Clean Transportation Zone (CTZ).

A raw agricultural product is any agricultural commodity or product in its raw or natural form, including a commodity or product derived from livestock, fruits in their unpeeled natural form, and other commodities or products marketed in the United States for human or livestock consumption.

**Please refer to Appendix D of the Request for Grant Applications (RFGA) to determine if an activity is eligible for this exemption.**

Applicants applying under the raw agricultural product transport exemption must complete this form and submit it with TNGVGP Application (TCEQ-20625). Projects with different percentages allocated in the eligible areas must submit a separate copy of this form for each activity.
