Figure 1: Number of Notices of Violation

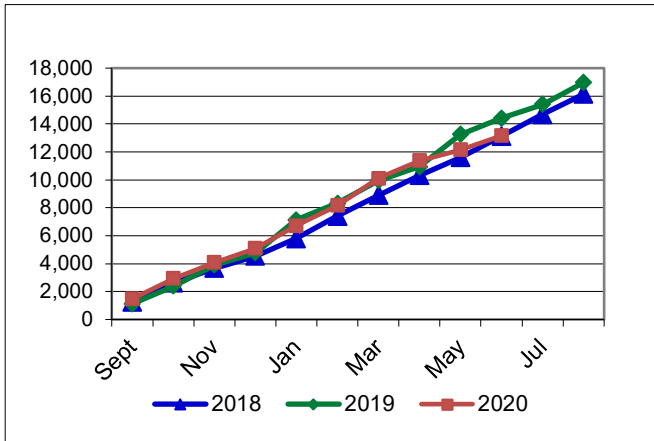
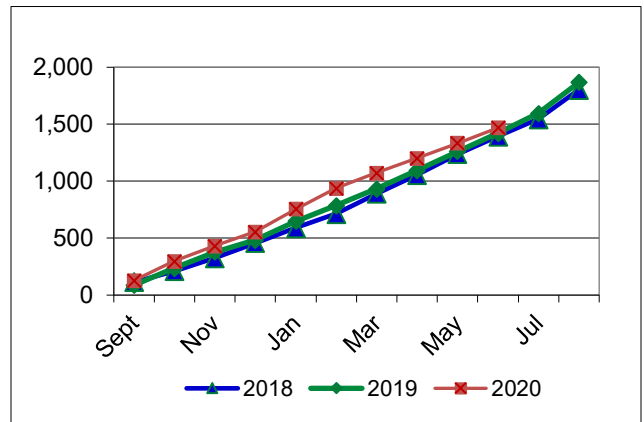


Figure 2: Number of Enforcement Action Referrals

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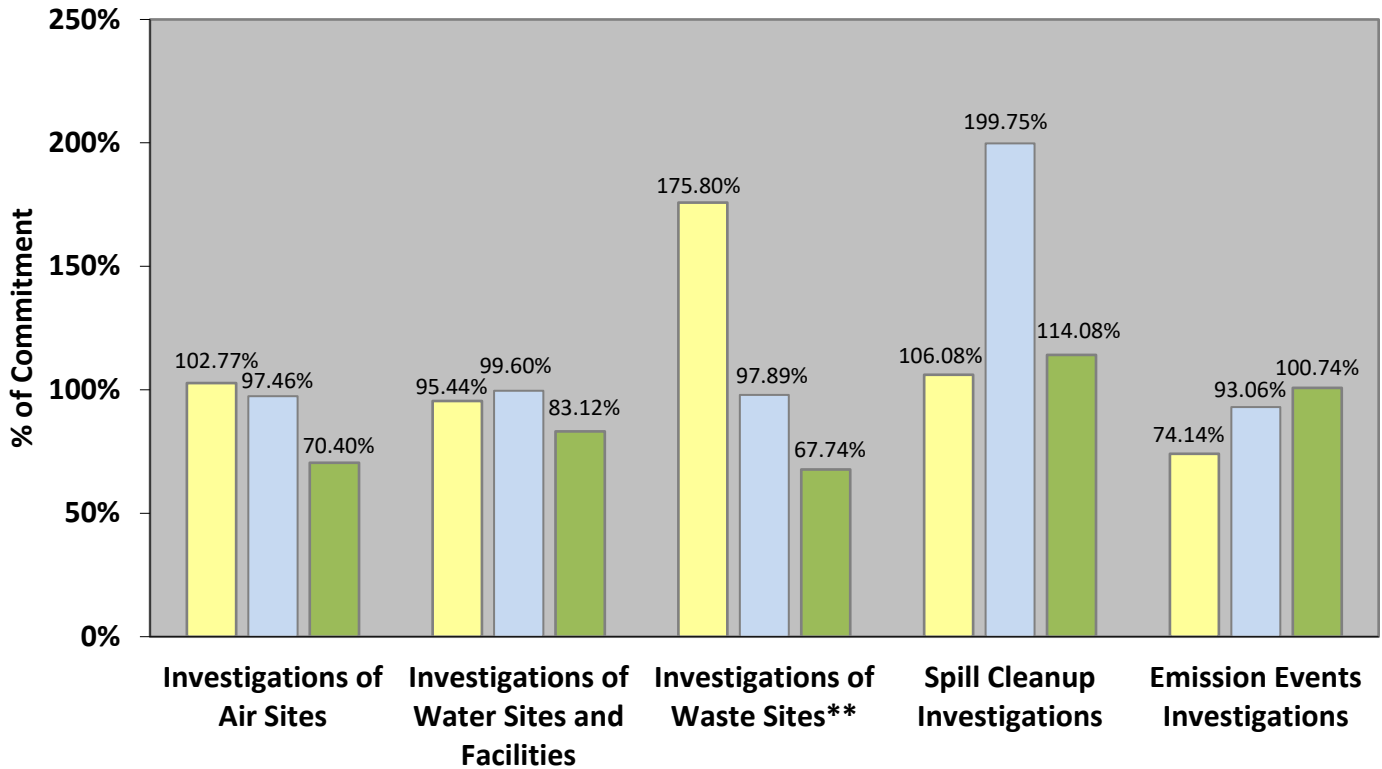
