Why have a QAPP?

- Structure assures quality.
- Primacy for Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA)
 - Decisions on compliance/enforcement
- Drinking Water Compliance Data in Texas
 - Requirements defined by rules
 - Federal and State
 - TNI accreditation - foundation
 - QAPP - specific

Framework of the PWSSP Quality System

- CFR – defines rules for PWS
- EPA – delegates enforcement authority to TCEQ for rules and defines requirements for quality documentation
- TCEQ Program – documents quality requirements in QAPPs, SOPs, RGs, etc.
- PWS Operators – document quality system structure in Monitoring Plans
