Who May File a Complaint?

Any person may file a <u>valid</u> complaint against any individual relating to any phase of landscape irrigation. Many municipalities and water districts have adopted landscape irrigation programs. Contact your local water purveyor to determine if a complaint can be resolved at the local level.

How do I File a Complaint?

A. Complaints must be in writing and submitted on this form (TCEQ-10380) or another format that provides the same required information. Without the required information, the TCEQ will not be able to investigate the complaint.

B. Describe the complaint in detail. Include dates, time, location (physical address) and name. Attach additional documentation such as copies of plans, contract documents, photographs, etc.

How Will I Know the Status of My Complaint?

A. Visit the Agency's Web site at: <u>http://www2.tceq.texas.gov/oce/waci/index.cfm</u>.

B. Contact the TCEQ in writing, by e-mail at <u>install@tceq.texas.gov</u>, or by telephone for a periodic status of your report by calling 512/239-LAWN.

C. If the nature of the complaint is outside the agency's jurisdiction, you will be notified in writing. If your information is provided on the complaint form (TCEQ-10380), you will be notified via e-mail.

What Complaints are Within the Agency's Jurisdiction?

Any landscape irrigation violation of the Texas Water Code chapter 37, Occupations Code, chapter 1903, and Texas Administrative Code, chapter 344.

What is the Complaint Process?

A. The complaint is received, reviewed, and assigned to a Landscape Irrigation Program investigator.

B. The Complainant (if known) may be contacted for additional information.

C. The person upon whom the complaint has been filed (Respondent) will be contacted.

D. The investigation may result in one or a combination of the following:

- 1. Written notice of violation (mailed to complainant).
- 2. License suspension or revocation.
- 3. Enforcement Action: administrative or civil penalty.
- 4. Dismissal of complaint due to insufficient evidence.

5. Referral to municipality with Landscape Irrigation Program ordinance.

SAMPLE AFFIDAVIT LANGUAGE

Example 1:

On <<DATE>> I observed a truck parked outside my neighbor's house. The truck advertised Landscape Irrigation by <<Business Name>> with license number <<LICENSE>> clearly identified on the truck. I observed an irrigation system being installed at <<ADDRESS>> on that same day (<<OR on what date>>) by employees of <<Business Name>>. I know the workers were employed by <<Business Name>> because (ex. They were wearing shirts identifying them as such; they drove away in the truck; they were using tools from the truck, etc).

I checked the TCEQ database and noted that the license number on the vehicle was expired (or belonged to another individual).

Example 2:

On <<DATE>> I received <<name of the publication>>. The publication advertised sprinkler system installation and repair and did not include a license number on the advertisement. I contacted <<Business Name>> on <<DATE>> and asked if they employed a licensed irrigator to perform sprinkler system installation and repairs. <<Name>>, <<Position, i.e., Owner, Secretary, Supervisor>>, told me that they were not required to have a licensed irrigator. I provided the original publication to TCEQ on <<DATE>>.

Example 3:

On <<DATE>> I was asked to provide an estimate to repair an irrigation system installed at <<ADDRESS>>. During my visit, I observed that the <<irrigation system did not have head-to-head coverage, as evidence by - explain how you determined the coverage was not met. >> I observe a sticker on the controller noting that <<NAME>> installed the irrigation system. The irrigation system owner confirmed this information. I have attached a photograph of the controller showing the sticker that I observed.
