This free voluntary program helps Texas public schools and regulated child care facilities test for lead in drinking water and take action to reduce lead where children are served. Lead is tasteless, odorless, and colorless in water – testing is the only way to know if lead is present.

What Does the Program Offer?

- The program is free. Program training, support, and sample analysis is provided at no cost.
- Following EPA guidance, the program team provides technical assistance and on-going support for participants to successfully complete the program.
- All materials and instructions are included and delivered directly to you. With the proper training, any member of your staff can collect samples.
