Landscape Irrigator/Technician License Affidavit
(Applicants for a new license, reactivation or renewal)

I, _____, hereby acknowledge that upon reactivation of my Landscape Irrigator or Technician License, I, in accordance with 30 Texas Administrative Code, Chapter 30, Subchapter D, Section 30.120(e), may no longer engage in any irrigation inspections that rely upon or require a valid Irrigation Inspector License. I understand that I have chosen to become ineligible to perform duties that require a valid Irrigation Inspector License.

These restrictions apply to, but are not limited to, the following licenses issued by TCEQ:

1. Landscape Irrigator License; or
2. Landscape Irrigation Technician License.

To reactivate the Irrigation Inspector license, I shall notify the TCEQ by submitting a new Irrigation Inspector License Affidavit.

I understand that, should I decide to reactivate and use my Irrigation Inspector License prior to its expiration date, I will be required to reapply for the license and pass the applicable exam. If, however, I choose to reactivate and use my Irrigation Inspector License upon renewal of such license, I will not be required to retake the exam if I meet all the renewal requirements (including completed continuing education along with a renewal application and fee).
