

 - New Permits
 - Permit Renewals (every 10 years)
 - Permit Modification (Class 1, 1-1, 2, & 3)
 - Permit amendments (Major and Minor)
 - Reports Combustion, Closure, Construction, Groundwater, Biennial and others
- Coal Combustion Residuals (CCR) Registration Program of 40 CFR
 257 Subpart D
- Manage Hazardous Waste Combustion Program

 - > 335.6 Notifications

 - On-site Non-hazardous Waste Land-based Units





IHW Permitted Sites


- Active Sites 181


Permitted Units by Type

 Units, 2 Static Detonation)




TCEQ Regions 5, 10, 12, 14
