Title 30 Texas Administrative Code (Tex. Admin. Code) §§ 111.171, 111.173, and 111.175 reference § 3.10(e) of the Texas Clean Air Act (TCAA) from the Texas Health and Safety Code. However, § 3.10(e) doesn't exist. Is the correct reference § 382.020?
Determination:
The reference to § 3.10(e) of the TCAA from the Texas Health and Safety Code contained in 30 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 111.171, 111.173, and 111.175 should be § 382.020.

Interpretation Request:	
Title 30 Texas Administrative Code (Tex. Admin. Code) § 111.175 exempts persons affected by § 382.020 of the Texas Clean Air Act (TCAA) (Texas Health and Safety Code) from 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 111.111 and other related sections. Section 382.020 references the control of particulate matter from plants at which certain agricultural products are handled, loaded, unloaded, dried, manufactured, or processed. What constitutes a plant?	
Determination:	
Only the emission points which are included in the manufacturing unit (those which handle, load, unload, dry, manufacture, or process grain, seed, legumes, or vegetable fibers) are exempt per 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 111.175 from 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 111.111 and the other related sections.
