## 30 TAC Chapter 115/460 Standards

## Areas: Dallas/Fort Worth and Houston/Galveston/Brazoria

- <u>§115.461(a)</u> Exemption for property with uncontrolled total actual VOC emissions of less than 3.0 tons per calendar year
- <u>§115.461(b)</u> Exemption for a process or operation subject to another division of 30 TAC Chapter 115 that specifies solvent cleaning operation requirements for that process or operation.
- <u>§115.461(c)</u> Exemption for a process or operation that is subject to another division in Chapter 115
- <u>§115.461(d)</u> Exemption for an operation, process, or equipment which is specified in §115.461(d)(1)-(17).
- §115.461(e) Exemption for cleaning solvents supplied in aerosol cans
- <u>\$115.463(a)(1)</u> Limiting VOC content of cleaning solution to 0.42 pound of VOC per gallon of solution (lb VOC/gal solution)
- <u>§115.463(a)(2)</u> Limiting composite partial vapor pressure of the cleaning solution to 8.0 millimeters of mercury at 20 degrees Celsius (68 degrees Fahrenheit)
- <u>§115.463(b)</u> Operating a vapor control system capable of achieving an overall control efficiency of 85% by mass
- <u>§115.464</u> Alternative method of demonstrating and documenting compliance
