- [§117.423\(a\)|1](#) Alternative NOx emission specification to §117.405 or §117.410 based on source cap limitation
- [§117.425\(a\)|1](#) Alternative CO emission specification to §117.405(d) or §117.410(c) as approved by the executive director
- [§117.425\(a\)|2](#) Alternative NH<sub>3</sub> emission specification to §117.405(d) or §117.410(c) as approved by the executive director
