Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Amendment Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 101384

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

TRP Crude Marketing, LLC (CN605291947) has submitted an application for renewal of and amendment to permit number 101384. The National Crude Marketing, LLC (RN105759450) facility produces/ manufactures petroleum distillates at 29565 *Highway* 124, Winnie, 77655, Jefferson County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of petroleum distllate purchase, storage and blending. The amendment will authorize inclusion of facilities to treat and recover product from high solids distillates.TRP Crude Marketing, LLC has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed are controlled by a vapor recovery system and a flare. The new and/or modified facilities will be controlled by the same system.
