

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Amendment Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 102530

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Cardinal Health (CN601503253) has submitted an application for renewal of and amendment to permit number 102530. The manufacturer and health care distribution warehouse (RN102958253) manufactures laminated non-woven material for surgical gowns and drapes at 1 Butterfield Trail Boulevard, El Paso, El Paso County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of the manufacturer of laminated non-woven material for surgical gowns and drapes and the health care distribution warehouse. The amendment will authorize an amendment of the Permit to incorporate an additional emission unit which will include the venting of trailer trucks containing boxed medical products that have been sterilized using ethylene oxide. Cardinal Health has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed are controlled by best management practices including the use of compliant adhesives to reduce VOC emissions. The new and/or modified facilities will be controlled by best management practices.
