## Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Change of Location Application for Air Quality Permit Number 105439L003

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Patriot Dozer Service, LLC (CN603948266) has submitted an application for a Change of Location for Air Quality Permit No. 105439L002. The Rock Crushing Plant 2 SN 80751 facility (RN106496656) will produce crushed rock at a facility located at 1118 San Pablo Road Bruni, Webb County, Texas 78344.

This permit will authorize the Change of Location of a portable rock crushing facility with a maximum production rate of 450 tons per hour and 1,965,600 tons per year with a maximum operating schedule of 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, 52 weeks per year, and 4,368 hours per year. Patriot Dozer Service, LLC has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The existing facilities are controlled by water sprays. Roads and traffic areas located within the site's boundary will be watered to control dust. Dust from stockpiles will be minimized by watering.
