

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 106169**

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Indorama Ventures Oxides LLC (CN605743038) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 106169. The Port Neches Operations F-8 Unit (RN100219252) produces/manufactures petrochemical manufacturing at 2701 Spur 136, Port Neches, Jefferson County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of the F-8 Unit and incorporate Permit by Rule Registration No. 157572 and a portion of Permit by Rule Registration No. 169507. Indorama Ventures Oxides LLC has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.
