

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Amendment Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 110664

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Motiva Enterprises LLC (CN600124051) has submitted an application for renewal of and amendment to permit number 110664. The Port Neches Chemical Terminal (RN107591323) stores Petroleum Refining Fractions at 100 E Port Neches Avenue, Port Neches, Jefferson County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of product storage tanks and barge loading and control. The amendment will incorporate previously registered Permit by Rules and Standard Permit to operate fugitives and storage tanks. Motiva Enterprises has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed are controlled by floating roofs and a vapor combustor unit. The new and/or modified facilities will be controlled by a floating roof.
