

## Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Amendment Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 110956

*The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.*

AES Drilling Fluids, LLC (CN603703596) has submitted an application for renewal and amendment to permit number 110956. The Rincon Industrial Park Distribution Facility (RN106585409) produces/manufactures processed minerals at 4030 Rincon Road, Corpus Christi, Nueces County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of the receiving, crushing, milling, drying, and loadout operations. The amendment will authorize an increase in the facility's annual throughput and the addition of a new radial stacker. AES Drilling Fluids, LLC has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.
