

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Certification
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 117592**

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Fox Creek Cedar Oil LLC (CN604526566) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 117592. The Cedar Oil Extraction Plant (RN107122731) produces/manufactures eastern red cedar essential oil at 6211 FM 100, Honey Grove TX, Fannin County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of a cedar oil extraction plant. Fox Creek Cedar Oil LLC has certified there will be no changes to the permit. The following permitted emission rates will remain the same. Pollutant Total Amount Allowed (tons per year)

The facilities being renewed continue to be controlled by cyclone, bag house, and ash collection systems.
