Magellan Processing, L.P. (CN604541797) has submitted an application for renewal and amendment of permit number 118270. The Corpus Christi Splitter (RN102536836) is a condensate material processing facility at 1802 Poth Ln, Corpus Christi, Nueces County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of the Corpus Christi Splitter. The amendment will authorize minor changes to previous representations. Magellan Processing, L.P. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.
