

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Certification**  
**Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 133873**

*The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.*

Continental Carbon Company (CN600619407) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 133873. The Sunray Carbon Black Plant (RN102321577) produces carbon black at 11702 Carbon Black Road, Sunray, Texas, Moore County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of storage tanks, reactors, boilers, dryers, flares, loading operations, associated piping equipment, and maintenance, start up, and shutdown activities. Continental Carbon Company has certified there will be no changes to the permit. The following permitted emission rates will remain the same.
