Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Amendment Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 160710

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Energy Transfer Nederland Terminal LLC (CN605971894) has submitted an application for an amendment to permit number 160710. The Nederland LPG Terminal (RN111476404) will store, manage, and deliver ethane, propane and butane at 2300 North Twin City Highway, Nederland, Jefferson County.

This amendment will authorize storage, managing, and delivery of ethylene and propylene in addition to current authorization to handle ethane, propane, and butane and the construction of a separate flare that will share emission limits with the existing flare. Energy Transfer Nederland Terminal LLC has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.
