Plain Language Summary for Concrete Batch Plant Standard Permit Application for Concrete Batch Plant Standard Permit Registration Number 169328L001

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Alamo Concrete Products Company (CN600240212) has submitted an application to register two temporary concrete batch plants under the Air Quality Standard Permit for Concrete Batch Plants for registration number 169328L001. The concrete batch plants (RN109280081) will be located at 3101 Industrial Boulevard, Temple, Bell County.

This registration will authorize the concrete batch plants to have a combined maximum production rate of less than 300 cubic yards per hour of concrete and operate up to 8,760 hours per year for the completion of a single project onsite for Temple Data Center. Particulate matter will be emitted from the handling of aggregate, cement, and flyash. Roads, traffic areas, and stockpiles will be watered to control dust. Enclosures and baghouses will be used to control cement and flyash dust.
