Plain Language Summary for Concrete Batch Plant Standard Permit Application for Concrete Batch Plant Standard Permit Registration Number [170487]

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Bell Concrete, Inc. (CN605286335) has submitted an application to register two permanent concrete batch plants under the Air Quality Standard Permit for Concrete Batch Plants for registration number [170487]. The concrete batch plants (RN111492211) will be located approximately 0.5-mile northwest of the intersection of CR 4450 and CR 4415, Trenton, Fannin County.

This registration will authorize the two concrete batch plants to have a maximum site-wide production rate of less than 300 cubic yards per hour of concrete and operate up to 8,760 hours per year. Particulate matter will be emitted from the handling of aggregate, cement, and flyash. Roads will be paved, and traffic areas will be watered to control dust. Dust from stockpiles will be minimized by watering. Enclosures and baghouses will be used to control cement and flyash dust.
