

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Amendment Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number T-17104

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Evonik Oil Additives USA, Inc. (CN604169367) has submitted an application for renewal of and amendment to permit number T-17104. The Evonik Oil Additives USA (RN101383859) produces/manufactures Oil Additives Products at 1700 Tidal Road, Deer Park, Harris County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of the Oil Additives Unit. The amendment will authorize the modified emission rates of the Volatile Organic Compounds from the facility. Evonik Oil Additives USA, Inc. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed are either fixed-roof storage tanks or are controlled by scrubbers. The new and/or modified facilities are fixed-roof storage tanks having low vapor pressure resulting in low emissions.
