

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Initial Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 171387

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Frontera Materials, Inc. (CN600518575) has submitted an application for initial permit number 171387. The La Joya Crushing Plant (RN111626222) will produce crushed rock at 13665 FM 2221 N, La Joya, Hidalgo County.

This permit will authorize a crushing, screening, and washing plant. Frontera Materials, Inc. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities will be controlled by water sprays. Stockpiles and roads will be watered to control dust.
