## Plain Language Summary for Concrete Batch Plant Standard Permit Application for Concrete Batch Plant Standard Permit Registration Number 171823

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

57 Concrete, LLC (CN605696293) has submitted an application to register a permanent concrete batch plant under the Air Quality Standard Permit for Concrete Batch Plants for registration number 171823. The concrete batch plant (RN111671277) will be located on the north side of the intersection of Turner Street and Ratliff Street, San Benito, Cameron County.

This registration will authorize the concrete batch plant to have a maximum production rate of less than 80 cubic yards per hour of concrete and operate up to 8,760 hours per year. Particulate matter will be emitted from the handling of aggregate, cement, and flyash. Roads will be paved, and traffic areas will be watered to control dust. Dust from stockpiles will be minimized by watering. Enclosures and baghouses will be used to control cement and flyash dust.
