The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

United Dirt Contractors, Inc (United) (CN603116450) has submitted an application for initial permit number 171895. The Miller Pit (RN111107793) will produce/manufacture gravel and is located seven miles south of Lawn, on Highway 382, on the south side of the road, in Runnels County.

This permit will authorize a rock crushing operation that will process material at a rate of up to 500 tons per hour. United has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.
