

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Initial Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 172972

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Texas Aggregates LLC (CN605380070) has submitted an application for Initial Permit Number 172972. The Smithville Plant (RN111743761) will produce sand and gravel at 301 Farm-to-Market 153, Smithville, Bastrop County.

This permit will authorize a rock crusher to handle oversize mined material. Texas Aggregates has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

Pollutant	Proposed Emissions (Tons Per Year)
PM	0.07
PM10	0.03
PM2.5	0.005

The new facilities will be controlled by mining only wet material and keeping it wet with water sprays throughout the process.
