

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Initial
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number [No. 174231]**

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Armorock, LLC (CN606111763) has submitted an application for initial permit number 174231. The Armorock facility (RN111684601) will produce/manufacture corrosion resistant sanitary sewer pipes, manhole stations, and other products constructed of polymer concrete at 207 Heritage Court, Sulphur Springs, Hopkins County.

This permit will authorize operational equipment used in the production of polymer concrete products. Armorock, LLC has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

Emissions from the site will be controlled by a thermal oxidizer (VOC, HAP) and dust collectors/fabric filters (PM, PM₁₀, PM_{2.5}).
